## Disposable Humidifier

Directions for Use:

NOTE: These directions are general guidelines intended for use by qualified medical personnel.

- Fill the humidifier jar to the maximum fill line with sterile, distilled or bottled water. Tightly secure the lid to the jar.
- 2. Connect the humidifier lid wing nut to the oxygen flowmeter outlet.
- Attach oxygen tubing (not supplied) to the humidifier lid outlet stem. Be sure all connections are secure.
- Turn the oxygen source to the prescribed flow.

CAUTION: An alarm whistle from the pressure relief valve will activate if the jar accumulates too much pressure. Inspect the system for excessive blockage or a kinked tube.

To test the pressure relief valve, occlude oxygen tubing at 3 LPM. Listen for an alarm condition.

WARNING: Oxygen supplies of 10 psi or less using low flow (less than 2 LPM) may affect the audible alarm.
